Holidays

The district will observe the following school holidays and will not operate on these days:

- 1. New Year's Day (January 1);
- 2. Martin Luther King, Jr. Day (third Monday in January);
- 3. Presidents' Day (third Monday in February);
- 4. Memorial Day (last Monday in May);
- 5. Juneteenth (June 19);
- 6. Independence Day (July 4);
- 7. Labor Day (first Monday in September);
- 8. Veterans Day (November 11);
- 9. Thanksgiving Day (fourth Thursday in November);
- 10. Native American Heritage Day (fourth Friday in November); and
- 11. Christmas Day (December 25).

Whenever any legal holiday falls on Saturday, the preceding Friday will be a non-school/non-work day. Whenever any legal holiday falls on Sunday, the following Monday will be a non-school/non-work day.

Other days, in addition to the holidays noted in this policy, may be deemed non-school days for students and/or non-work days for staff in accordance with state law and collective bargaining agreements.
