The district continues to improve in balancing the goal of reducing exclusionary discipline practices while minimizing disruption to the learning environment. It is also important to address disparities for certain subgroups (students with IEPs, low income, and African American).

Three years of disrupted instruction have had a negative effect not only on student learning but also student conduct. Efforts to return to normal and mitigate the effects of COVID on student conduct present continuing challenges.
